Dumpster Conditions

We have again booked a dumpster this fall. Remember that *appliances, TV's, oil, BBQ's need be taken to one of the city's Eco centers and will not be accepted in the dumpsters.*

NOTE this service is FREE to fully paid up members of RRHOA. If you are not a member at this time and would like to use the service, you can pay for your membership at the site.
